

H2020 EO Big Data Hackathon Privacy Policy Statement



1 Privacy Policy

This is the privacy and data protection policy for the event “H2020 EO Big Data Hackaton”, which will take place in Frascaty (Italy) on November 7th and 8th 2019. The event is organized by the projects **CANDELA** (Copernicus Access Platform Intermediate Layers Small Scale Demonstrator), European Union’s Horizon 2020 grant agreement No 776193 (<http://www.candela-h2020.eu/>), **BETTER** (Big data earth observation technology and tools enhancing research and development), European Union’s Horizon 2020 grant agreement No 776280 (<https://www.ec-better.eu/>), **EOPEN** (Open interoperable platform for unified access and analysis of earth observation data), European Union’s Horizon 2020 grant agreement No 776019 (<https://eopen-project.eu/>), **OpenEO** (Open source interface between earth observation data infrastructures and front-end applications), European Union’s Horizon 2020 grant agreement No 776242 (<https://openeo.org/>), and **PerceptiveSentinel** (Big data knowledge extraction and re-creation platform) European Union’s Horizon 2020 grant agreement No 776115 (<http://www.perceptivesentinel.eu/>). This Privacy Policy is referred to CANDELA project.

1.1 Legal Framework

Personal data related to online registration shall be processed in accordance with the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (General Data Protection Regulation – GDPR) of the European Parliament and of the Council of 27 April 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data¹, and replacing the Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation).

1.2 What personal information do we collect from you?

The personal data collected and further processed by the project CANDELA are the following:

- ▶ Data necessary for the organisation and management of the event, namely: name, surname, company, project and professional email.
- ▶ Photographs/pictures taken from attendees during the event and within the venue of the event for visibility and dissemination purposes of the event.
- ▶ Audio and video recording of speakers and participants used to sustain consortium deliverables for the European Commission.

CANDELA also requests your explicit consent to the use of your data.

1.3 Purposes of the use of your personal data

Personal data in the context of this event is processed for the following project purposes:

- ▶ the management/organisation of the (lists for contacts, invitations, reports and follow-up)
- ▶ the visibility of the event (news and publications on all kind of supports)
- ▶ the consortium deliverables and reports towards the European Commission.

1.4 Technical means used to collect your personal data

For registration purposes, CANDELA uses the means provided by the Eventbrite, a global platform for events. They have their own privacy policy that can be found at the following URL: https://www.eventbrite.com/support/articles/en_US/Troubleshooting/eventbrite-eu-data-protection.

The CANDELA consortium processes these personal data collected from Eventbrite for managing the event.

Photographs, pictures, audio/video recording are handled by the communication team of CANDELA consortium during the event. This information will be stored in a repository, on behalf of the CANDELA consortium, by Atos Spain SAU (“Atos”), with registered office in Albarracin 25, 28037 Madrid, Spain. Nevertheless, any information displayed on the internet/intranet might be stored on servers of external contractors abiding by the necessary security provisions.

1.5 How do we protect your personal data?

As stated in [Atos Binding Corporate Rules](#), any personal data processed by Atos is kept on secure servers. Atos uses reasonable administrative, technical, personnel, and physical measures to safeguard personal data against loss, unauthorized access, use, disclosure, or modification and to ensure the integrity of the personal data. Additionally, Atos ensures to process your personal data only for the purposes mentioned in this privacy notice and to keep data no longer than necessary.

CANDELA repository is subject to the Atos Information Security Policy, aiming at safeguarding the confidentiality, integrity, availability, authenticity and non-repudiation of information and information systems. It is based on an internationally accepted security standard (ISO27002 -, Code of Practice for Information Security Management). Atos implements technical and organizational security measures to safeguard stored personal data against inadvertent or deliberate manipulation, loss or destruction and against access by unauthorized persons. Our security measures are continuously improved in line with technological progress, but remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your Personal Information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

1.6 Who has access to your personal data?

Data required for the management of the event from the Eventbrite platform might be accessible to the representatives of the 5 projects organising the event, and registration data might be shared with the other projects and Research and Innovation Agency (https://ec.europa.eu/info/departments/research-executive-agency_en) for purposes strictly related to the organisation of the Hackathon.

For visibility purposes, part of your personal data (pictures, video or audio recording) can be processed and diffused to a wider public (intranet, Internet, project deliverables). If you do not agree with your image or voice being recorded and published, please use the possibility to opt-out by contacting the project coordinator (see the Contact Information below) and explicitly specifying your request.

1.7 Data retention

Your personal data is kept as long as follow-up actions to the event are necessary with regard to the purposes of the processing of personal data as well as for the event and its related management.

1.8 How can you verify, modify or delete your information?

Event attendees have the right to access to their personal data.
